Red/Grey sweatshirt/jumper

Grey or black trousers

Summer

Smart grey or black shorts
-not sports wear

Sensible flat shoes
- no open toe sandals

Girls

Red/Grey sweatshirt/jumper or cardigan
White or red polo shirt
Grey or black skirt, pinafore or trousers
NB. Skirt lengths should not be too long, short or narrow as they can be dangerous at playtimes.

Red/white dress
Smart grey, black or red shorts
- not sports wear

Sensible flat shoes
- no open toe sandals



The following items are not permitted for school:

- *fashion wear in general
- *make-up
- *trainers
- *boots/shoes with high heels
- *nail varnish
- *dyed or tinted hair or patterns shaved into hair
- *decorative hair adornments or braids
- *jewellery, including body piercing, except a watch and a single set of small stud earrings.
