Dear Parents and Carers,

We had another busy week in Apple class.

In English, the children had the opportunity to innovate on our core story, 'The Gingerbread Man'. The children enjoyed changing the story in order to incorporate their own characters and then subsequently decide what their character would be baking. The children have created their own story maps. Our class version included changing The Gingerbread Man to The Chocolate Lady. We have started to write our innovated version of The Gingerbread Man.

Place value is still at the core of our Maths learning. The children have been provided with further opportunities to represent numbers using pictorial representations. Our focus for part of the week was on 1:1 correspondence, whereby the children would match objects or pictures to the correct number. The children would then be provided with questions that would allow them to problem solve and reason. We have also focused on comparing objects this week, using language such as greater than, less than and equal to.
