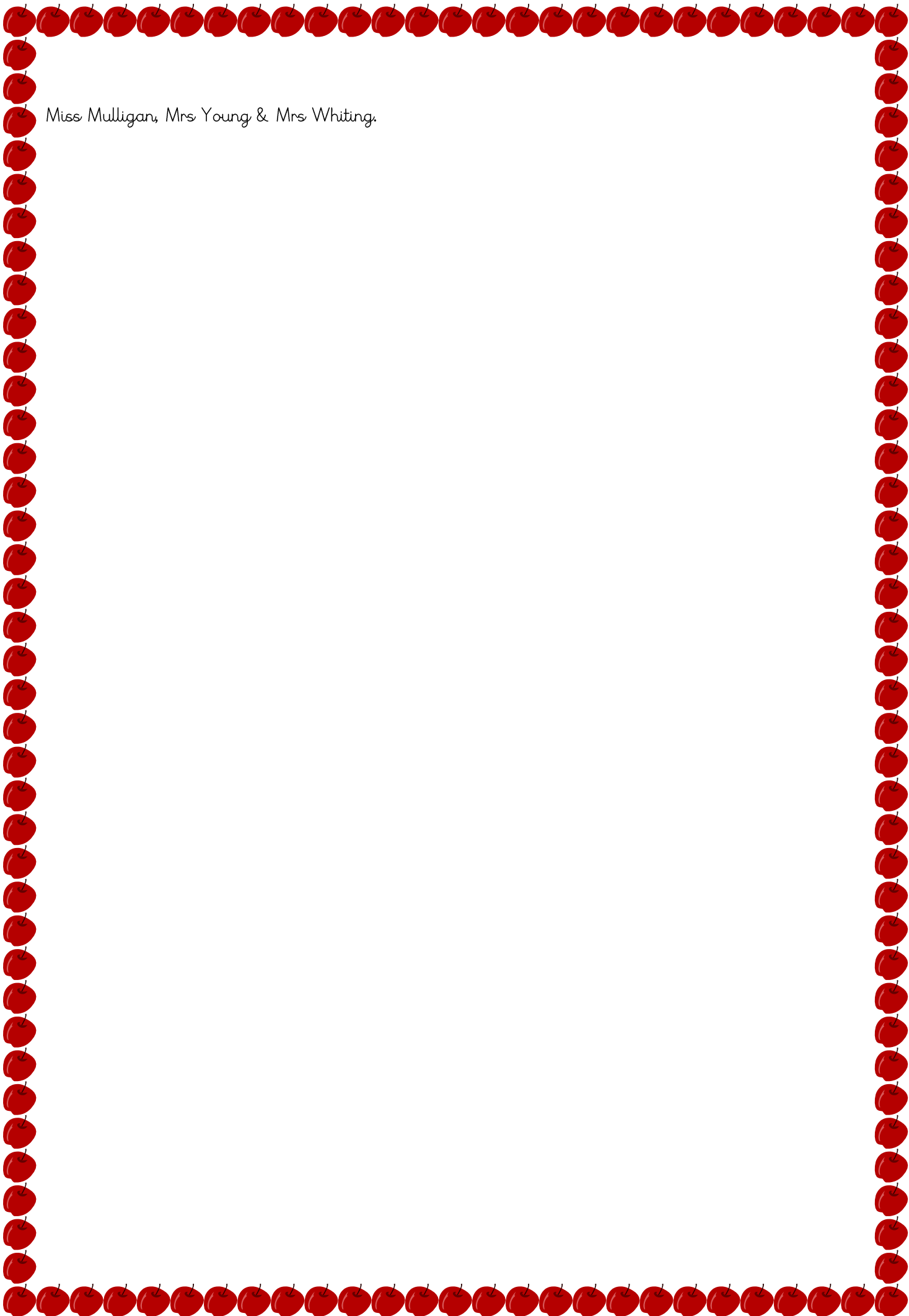
This week's spellings are high, flight, sight, night and sign. Please practice as many of them as possible. Thank you.
