Dear Parents/Carers

This week has been another busy week for the children in Acorn class. We are so pleased with the way that they are coming into school each morning now. They are also coping very well with the routines of the day and we are so proud of the wonderful progress that they are all making. They are all enjoying exploring their new environment and interacting with their new peers.

This week the children have participated in a daily maths meeting and are joining in with the songs and activities. We have also started doing some phonics work in preparation for starting to learn our letters and sounds next week.

As of next week, the children will all be bringing home a reading book. Many of them will initially be in the form of a picture book, which we would ask you to please talk about with your child on a regular basis. Initially the talking time can be for as long or as short as your child is engaged for. A little bit each day is recommended. Asking questions and making predictions about the book all prepares them for eventually reading, understanding and enjoying books.

We have noticed that many of the children are bringing in more than one snack a day. As it is close to lunch time we would request it's just something small to keep them going until lunch time.

Please be aware that should your child be going home with another adult other than yourselves, we do need to have this in writing in order to comply with safe guarding issues.

The children are really enjoying our junk modelling activity. We would appreciate any clean bottle tops, food/cereal boxes and kitchen roll tubes.
