Hello and welcome to the Summer edition of the Watlington Primary School PTA newsletter. We had a successful Spring term with **£240.73** raised from the school disco and £117.62 from the cake sale (with £30 to Comic Relief/**£87.62** to the school) – a fantastic effort all round – a total of **£328.35** to the school during last term-thank you for all your support! We also have the very welcome funds that are being raised via Your School Lottery. So far we there are 41 tickets being sold each weeks which means that we have raised £180 so far and are projected to make £850 per year! (at that rate – we aim to get over 50 tickets and hopefully more) Let's hope we can keep on going and get some more supporters on board to keep on raising that target! 😊 The children will be consulted on what project/development they would like to take place within school and we look forward to providing the funds in order for that to happen.
