Thank you for efforts with home learning at the beginning of the week.

This week in English we have completed our cold write for our persuasion unit. We received a copy of a diary entry from Kassim on the day of his adventure and he mentioned he would like some help to capture the dragon. The children became the villagers whom the dragons had stolen from and had to persuade the dragon catcher to help them. They were unsuccessful however as the dragon catcher thought they could do it themselves and not have to spend all their money on her. Our Words of the Week have been portrait, rarely and resplendent. Our SPaG focus is capital letters.

In maths we have been continuing to divide 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, in fact on Wednesday we were even dividing 100 into many different groups. We have looked at what happens when we divide a number into equal groups and there is some left over. For example $13 \div 3 = 4 \text{ r}1$ or $19 \div 5 = 3 \text{ r}4$

In art we have created our own pop art after looking at some of the artwork completed by Andy Warhol. We used laminating pouches and traced around a picture of a light bulb several times. The children then had to place small pieces of tissue paper on to the light bulb and covered the back with a contrasting coloured card. They were then laminated.

After half term we are doing PE on **Tuesdays and Fridays** again.
