Dear Parents & Carers,

The children have had a very busy week and continue to wow us with their knowledge and skills. Their attitude to learning is great and they have shown resilience when encountering new learning materials. This includes their engagement with the English this week where we have started to learn about persuasive writing and how we can use persuasion in a letter to try to convince our audience to join in or engage with an activity. The children have drawn upon their knowledge of adjectives and verbs as well as the use of dialogue and inverted comments to make their writing powerful.

In Maths this week we have been developing our knowledge about measuring, specifically comparing height and length and using the associated vocabulary. The children are able to compare three objects and talk about which is taller/shorter and which are longer and shorter. The children have been working on saying their answers in sentences to convey their depth of understanding and then recording this in writing.

In Art this week the children have experimented with pop art and used printing techniques to create a flower painting. We have also looked closely at the Van Gogh painting entitled Sunflowers. The children have drawn their sunflower replica and paid particular attention to the shape, patterns and positioning of the sunflowers. Their eye for detail has really impressed us. Well done Apple Class.
