Dear Parents/carers,

We have had a great week in Acorn Class!

In literacy this week, we created a text map in preparation for writing instructions on how to make a pancake. The children will use their own text maps to support them in writing their instructions. We are encouraging them to apply their phonics by sounding out the words they are spelling.

In maths this week, we have focused on subitising (recognising numbers without needing to count them). They have been describing the arrangements they have made through subitising, by talking about the position of the arrangements and composition of the numbers.

In RE, this week we learnt about the meaning behind Pancake Day and how it is a way that Christians prepare for lent.

In our well-being and life skills lessons, we learnt about the things that we should do in public and private places. For example, we discussed how going to the toilet happens in private but going to the park is more public.

The children have also created some pop art alongside all the artistic activities that they access throughout their continuous provision.
