The children have had to put their visualisation skills to the test this week, trying to identify hidden cubes in order to find the total volume of a range of solids. I have been particularly impressed with how the class have applied their knowledge of following formulas in order to find the area and volume.

Oak Class have all been extremely motivated during our English as we develop our ideas and planning dual perspective stories. They have been so enthused by their ideas, that they have continued to talk to lunchtime staff about it after the lesson.
