Dear Parents/carers,

We have had a great week in Acorn Class!

In literacy this week, the children completed their instruction writing. We have now come to the end of this unit of work. They also practiced writing words and sentences using their phonics.

In maths this week, we have focused on comparing objects of different heights and lengths. We then used some non-standard measures to measure different objects. For example, the books are 2 blocks long. We also focused on ordering numbers this week using one of our counting principles. We made sure that each number was in order. The Number blocks supported us with this.

In RE, this week the children learnt more about lent and considered any items that they could give up for lent if this was something they participated in.

In our well-being and life skills lessons, we considered activities that occur in public and activities that occur in private. The children were required to stand on one side of a line if they thought the activity was public such as swimming and the other side of the line if they felt the activity was private such as getting changed.
